Bookmark this page and refer to it daily. The Assignor runs the main page as a near real-time blog so that you have accurate up-to-the hour information. This is critical on heavy weather days.

Sportsmanship ratings **start at 40**, with deductions as noted. This rating is a crew decision. Don't decide on your own. Get input. If you deduct a few points for fan, coach, or player conduct please explain in remarks.

Remarks should be concise, precise, and clear. Don't leave the Commissioner guessing. A good practice is to reread for clarity before you publish.

Put your first and last name (referee) in different fields, as noted. Otherwise it comes out garbled at the receiving end. Always include your crew (full) names. Take the time to get the names right and spelled correctly---full names.

Before submitting your game report, you can print it. Please review to make sure all fields are accurate and complete. Please make sure all fields are accurate and complete. For example, if you don't include a numerical score for sportmanship you could cost a school a chance for the Goddart sportmanship award.

Note: You will have the option to view and print after submitting your report. If after submitting the game report you feel that you MUST change data, resubmit a second report and add a comment that it's a duplicate report to correct an error in the first report.

Your narrative must be concise, clear, and complete. It goes to the schools and to VHSL. The Commissioner must know what happened, with precision. Report facts – no personal opinions. Use the NFHS Soccer Rules Book for correct wording, if necessary.

Note:

1. Call immediately after issuing a red card (703-966-0457) and leave a message.
2. Report must be submitted within 24 hours.
3. Second yellow card ejection DOES require a rejection report.
4. Fighting carries a TWO game suspension, so make sure that if you have a fighting ejection you clearly say so and the coaches know that you consider it a *fight*.
5. That you must NOTIFY the coaches the reason for the ejection at the time of the ejection.

Before submitting your ejection report, please review the information for accuracy. You will not be able to change it once submitted.
